# **KURIOS**

Mark 5:1-20 | February 4 Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

**Reflect** | Can you think of a time when a vacation, mission trip, or work trip turned into something unexpected? What happened? How did you and/or your peers or family handle the situation?

**Excavate** | "Unclean," within ancient Judaism, signals ritual or moral impurity. What is "unclean" in this narrative according to the Old Testament scriptures?

**Interpret** | What do you think it says about lesus and his lordship that he willingly enters into a situation marked by such "uncleanness" (e.g. pagan land, graveyard, evil spirits, pigs, etc.) and brings about restoration? How does this change the way you see Jesus in your own life but also in the lives of those typically marked "unclean?"

**Examine** | When have you felt like the townspeople begging lesus to leave because he changes too much?

**Apply** | If lesus said to you, ""Go home to your friends and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you," which story (or stories) would you tell? Share that story with someone this week.

**Invite** | What is one way you can cross religious or social barriers to help someone else experience restoration and healing this week?
