Mark 16:14-20 | April 7

Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

**Reflect** | What signs of Christ's reign do you see in creation? Where do you long for signs of Christ's reign in creation?

**Excavate** | Where else in Scripture do you notice the accompanying signs that lesus mentions (e.g., miracles of lesus in Mark's Gospel and also accompanying signs in Acts 2, Acts 3, Acts 5 + 8. Acts 10 + 28. etc.)?

**Interpret** | Why do you think lesus says to preach the Good News to all creation? Who/what do you think is included?

**Examine** | How does the Great Commission fit into your understanding of work, vocation, and mission as an individual, couple, or family?

**Apply** | In what ways can you fulfill the Great Commission in your family, neighborhood, school/work, etc. this week?
