Reflect | Who has been a Good Samaritan in your life?

Excavate | Who do the priest and the Levite pass by (e.g. Leviticus 21 + Numbers 19)? Who were the Samaritans and why would a person be surprised that a Samaritan stopped?

Interpret | How do you think the scribe received the parable, and why?

Examine | Which of the people in the parable do you most identify with in this season of your faith journey: the harried priest/Levite, the broken and wounded man, the compassionate Samaritan, the gratuitously generous innkeeper? Why?

Apply | To whom will you be a Good Samaritan this week?

Invite | What spiritual wounds do you know of in the lives of the people in your life who are far from God and/or His Church? How can you place yourself "along the road to Jericho" in order to listen to them and bring healing this week?
