Isaiah 11:2-3a, Hebrews 1:1-3a, Revelation 22:16 December 10

Reflect | What is your favorite metaphor for God, and why?

Excavate | Read Isaiah 11:2-3a + Hebrews 1:1-3a + Revelation 22:16. What do these verses tell us about Jesus Christ?

Interpret | What is the significance of Jesus being the exact imprint of God's nature? What does it mean that Jesus is Goodness, Truth, and Beauty?

Examine | Jesus sent John to testify - bring a word of encouragement amidst a really challenging season - to the churches in Asia minor. Who has God sent to encourage you in hard seasons of your own life? How did you know?

Apply | What is one thing you can do this week that reflects the Goodness, Truth, and Beauty of Jesus?

Invite | What is a story that you can share about the Goodness, Truth, and Beauty of Jesus at work in your life with someone who is far from God or the people of God (the Church) this season?
