
WELCOME CENTER SERVICE OPPORTUNITY

Galatians | July 2 Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

Reflect | When you were a teenager, what was one "freedom" or "privilege" you looked forward to as an adult (e.g., driving, later bedtime, curfew, etc.)?

Excavate | Read Galatians 1-6, with a particular focus on Galatians 5. How does Paul describe freedom? What does Paul mean by the "yoke of slavery?"

Interpret | In Galatians 5:13-18, how does Paul navigate the twin dangers of legalism and license?

Examine | In Galatians 5:16-24, Paul describes the works of the flesh and the fruit of the Spirit. Which fruits of the Spirit are growing in your soul? Which fruits of the Spirit are budding? Which fruits of the Spirit are being choked out by weeds? Which works of the flesh have you conquered by the power of the Holy Spirit? Which works of the flesh are you battling in the Spirit?

Apply | In Christ, by the power of the Holy Spirit, we are freed *from* sin, but also freed *for* love of God and neighbor. What does God want to free you from this week? How is God inviting you to use your freedom to love Him and the people around you more fully this week?

Invite | When the opportunity arises, share a 2-3 minute story about your experience of freedom in Christ with a family member, neighbor, friend, or colleague this week.
