Letters From Home

**Colossians | July 23** Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

**Reflect** | What image comes to mind when you hear the word, "majesty?" Find a picture or image from your own collection or from Google that you think best points to God's majesty.

**Excavate** | Read Colossians 1-4, with a particular emphasis on Colossians 1. What unique attributes does Paul attribute to Jesus? Further, Paul describes Jesus as the "firstborn" of all creation. What are the rights and responsibilities of the firstborn in ancient Jewish culture?

**Interpret** | How does the Biblical theme of the firstborn shape your understanding of Paul's description of Jesus here in Colossians 1?

**Examine** | Paul describes Jesus as the one in whom all things hold together, which implies that there are sometimes unresolved parts, moments, and experiences in our faith journeys that perplex, confound, or even frustrate us e.g. the death of a child, the return of the cancer after miraculous healing, unfulfilled promises, etc. What unresolved parts, moments, or experiences from your own faith journey do you hope are being held together in Christ?

**Apply** | Paul also describes Jesus as the "firstborn of the new creation" and elsewhere describes us as "new creations" (2 Corinthians 5). What are some ways in which you've experienced new creation in your life with Jesus? What is one way Jesus is inviting you to live in conformity with new creation this week?

**Invite** | How might you give someone who does not yet know Christ or belong to a faith community a glimpse of "new creation" this week?
