## The Teacher

**Matthew 25:31-46 | March 26**

Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

**Reflect** | Thinking back over my own life, what was it like to receive one of the acts of mercy: feed the hungry, give water to the thirsty, clothe the naked, welcome the stranger, care for the sick (or injured), or visit the prisoner? Who extended this act of mercy to you?

**Excavate** | Read Matthew 25:31-46. What heavenly court scene does Jesus describe in vs. 31-33 e.g. throne, kingdom, etc.? Whose throne does Jesus come to inhabit? Who is invited into the kingdom? For what are they praised and welcomed?

**Interpret** | What does this passage reveal about God, God's kingdom, and what it means to participate in it?

**Examine** | Which of these acts of mercy come most naturally to me and which are more challenging for me? Why? What gets in my way e.g. my busyness, focus on family and friends, my distance from those in great need?

**Apply** | How is God leading me to greater acts of mercy, whether by personal (1:1) acts or by volunteering, starting, joining, or donating to a group that serves those in great need?

**Invite** | How might I explain to someone who does not yet follow Christ how beautiful Jesus' love is for those in great need? Who in your life, someone who does not yet follow Christ, might you invite to participate in one of these acts of mercy with you?
