*Casting Shadows***Deuteronomy 6 | October 8**

Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

Reflect | What have you learned about faith from watching the actions of your parents or other adults?**Excavate** | Read Deuteronomy 6. In the context of the surrounding nations, what does it mean when Moses says, “The Lord our God, the Lord is one” (v.4)?**Interpret** | What does it mean to love God with all one’s heart, soul, and strength?**Examine** | How does your own life, in word and deed, reflect your love for God?**Apply** | Moses essentially tells the people to keep the word of the Lord ever before them. Following the Spirit’s guidance, select a verse from the Scriptures to meditate on, discuss, or ponder this week.**Invite** | What is one intentional way that you can pass on the faith to the next generation (either a young person or a new believer) this week?
