Casting Shadows

Genesis 18:1-15 | **September 17** | Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

Reflect | When did you laugh the hardest this past week or month?

Excavate | If you were Sarah, how would you tell the story of Isaac's birth? What events from Genesis 11-21 would you include and why?

Interpret | Why does Sarah laugh (Genesis 18)?

Examine | Sarah once laughed cynically, now she rejoices in the laughter of her son. What unfulfilled expectations, promises, and hopes now prompt cynical laughter from you? Can you think of moments when God intervened and turned your disappointment to joy and laughter?

Apply | Write a song, poem, or short story that expresses both a lament to God for the unfulfilled expectations, promises, and hopes but also a praise for the ways God's intervention have led to joy and laughter.

Invite | How might you tangibly love someone who's discouraged or disappointed this week e.g. a card, a text, a gift card to a coffee shop, connecting over a coffee, meal, or beverage, etc?
