Hebrews | August 13

Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

Reflect | Which ordinary saints in your life have persevered in their faith, even in the face of challenges, doubts, or even success?

Excavate | Read Hebrews. To what figures and elements does the writer compare Jesus throughout Hebrews? How is Jesus similar to, but also different from, each of these figures and elements?

Interpret | What implications does each comparison have for the faith of the writer's first century Jewish Christian audience? Which of these comparisons resonates most with you in this season of your faith journey?

Examine | The writer of Hebrews exhorts the Jewish Christians to "look to Jesus" as they "run the race" and also warns them against "falling away" from what they've heard in and about Jesus Christ. What is currently sustaining your faith or helping you to "run the race?" What obstacles are weighing you down or hindering your faith journey?

Apply | In what ways is the Holy Spirit tangibly inviting you to "look to lesus" as the perfecter and founder of our faith this week?

Invite | Who in your life needs prayer and encouragement to persevere in their own faith journey? What tangible word and/or deed of encouragement can you offer to them this week?
